- Will reported that the Best Practices Committee has completed most of their projects. They are in the process of finalizing these to present to the Coordinating Board.
- Patrick reported that the meeting with Governor Lynch went well. He said that the Governor listened to our concerns and was very receptive. He will follow up with Governor's staff.
- Denis reported that we may want to follow HB 143. It concerns 3<sup>rd</sup> party liability and is being pushed by trial lawyers. It basically is looking at making it easier to go after someone even if they are not responsible for the incident that took place, but has the better liability coverage. It has passed the House and is currently in the Senate. It may not pass in the Senate. Denis strongly urged us to follow this and to print off a copy of the bill and show it to our insurance carriers. The bill may be view at [www.nh.gov](http://www.nh.gov).
- Patrick is still trying to work out a meeting with Dave Hogan and Jennifer Frenette to work on collaborative items.
- Jon reported that the website is coming along well. He has posted minutes from 2006 and on that he has been able to find. Denis is advertising on the site. He now has available on the site our mission statement, membership application, and different links. The tag board is still not getting a lot use, however he has contacted Dave Hogan from the Paramedic Association about using it for real-time communications for their association. Jon will look at making NH Ambulance Assoc. officer email addresses that will hyperlink to the officer's regular email addresses. The officer's page will be updated.

No other business or concerns were discussed.
